#### OLD GLORY DAYS

A very special thanks to those who made our Old Glory Days Celebration a great success. Many volunteers, along with members of the city staff, worked tirelessly to have an even better parade, with a longer parade route, and many other well-planned activities. #### AT HOME, THE HOME DECOR SUPERSTORE

The grand opening for Utah's first At Home Superstore is set for Saturday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, at the former Macy's building, 1134 W. Riverdale Road. The store has been completely remodeled with a new facelift and should bring new vitality to the Family Center. The At Home chain of superstores is based in Texas and is rapidly expanding to other states. According to their website, At Home "brings more than 30 years of passion and experience to the ever-evolving home décor category." We are very excited to have this new business in our community and wish them the very best of success. Note: An additional 30,000 square feet of floor space will be made available for another new tenant in the same building. The design has been approved for another entrance nearer to the south end of the building. Right now the space is available and we are awaiting for a new occupant to be named in the near future.

#### 4400 SOUTH BIKE-PEDESTRIAN PATHWAY UPDATE

The new 11' wide concrete pathway that will extend from Parker Drive under I-84 up to and over I-15 has been designed and has been approved by those agencies who provide approval for this type of project. It was hoped that this project would begin this summer, but right now it looks like an early spring start. The Federal Highway Administration had to approve the new bridge that will cross I-15 and this approval and other approvals took longer than expected. Rather than have the construction of this project take place during the winter months, the plan now is to advertise the project for bid in early December. By doing this, we should receive lower dollar bids for the project than if we advertised now when companies are very busy trying to finish projects before the winter months. Companies would also bid higher amounts for the cold weather construction. Having gained the support of Roy and Ogden City, this project has been approved for full funding with Weber County Transportation Funds. We are very excited to have this new safer "link" to Roy for cyclists and pedestrians and will push this forward as rapidly as possible.

### PRIMARY ELECTION INFORMATION



**Election Day:** The Primary Election will be held August 11<sup>th</sup>. Six candidates will advance to the General Election, which will be held November 3<sup>rd</sup>. All registered voters were mailed a vote-by-mail ballot on July 13<sup>th</sup>. Subsequent mailings were sent to voters that register after that date. If a voter does not receive a ballot they may contact Weber County 801-399-7411 or go to Riverdale City Hall on Election Day.

**Voting Options:** Voters will be able to cast their ballot in one of three ways:

- 1) Mail a ballot** with a First Class or Forever stamp affixed to it. All mail in ballots must be post marked by August 10<sup>th</sup> OR sooner.
- 2) Secure drop box** located at Riverdale City Hall; available Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. until August 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) Traditional voting** will be available on August 11<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Riverdale City Hall, 4600 South Weber Drive. In order to vote in person, you must present a qualifying ID, which includes your name and current address, along with your completed ballot. A list of qualifying ID's may be found at [vote.utah.gov/vote/menu/requirements.html](http://vote.utah.gov/vote/menu/requirements.html).

Please note because these are by-mail elections, no early voting will be offered, but ballots may be dropped in a secure box located at the city offices during regular business hours.

**Voting Questions:** You must have been a resident of Riverdale City for at least 30 days to be eligible to participate in the Primary Election. **Register to Vote:** Voter registration can be completed 30 days prior to election day via mail or online, or 15 days prior to Election Day in person in the office of the Weber County Recorder. ### FIRE HYDRANT TESTING

The Riverdale Fire Department will be testing all of the fire hydrants in the city in August and September. This test is designed to capture static and flow pressure readings to discover any potential fire hydrant performance issues for corrective action. The fire hydrant inspection also includes any maintenance the hydrant may require. The annual test and maintenance is also an important component of the Insurance Service Office grading of fire protection for the community, which results in lower fire insurance premiums for your home and business property.



Residents should check to be sure there is no discoloration, due to sediment in the line, before using any water during this period. If discoloration of water is noted after testing in their area, residents should allow their cold water taps to flow until the water clears. This will prevent any problems with the washing of clothes and dishes. If the discoloration remains or you see a problem with a fire hydrant, please call the Riverdale City Water Department at 801-394-5541 ext.1219.
