## ELECTION FILING PERIOD



If you have thought about serving as an elected official in Riverdale City, now is the time to prepare. Three City Council seats are up for election this year. Each elected office has a four year term.

**The filing period begins June 1<sup>st</sup> and ends on June 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.** Those wishing to seek office must file a Declaration of Candidacy with the Riverdale City Recorder. The form and Election Guide 2015 can be viewed and printed from the city website, [www.riverdalecity.com](http://www.riverdalecity.com), or picked up at the Civic Center, 4600 South Weber River Drive. The General Election will take place in November, with the Primary Election being held in August, if necessary.

## HELP CONSERVE WATER

The drought continues to impact the water supply in our area. To help conserve water we ask that residents closely monitor their outside water usage and cut back whenever possible. Being a little water conscious can go a long way in conserving water. Please follow these guidelines:



- Do not water between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- Adjust sprinkler heads to avoid watering driveways, sidewalks or other unnecessary areas.
- Turn off your sprinkler system on rainy days.
