"LIVE FIT RIVERDALE" PROMOTING WELLNESS AND A HEALTHY LIFESTYLE

As you read this newsletter, the 3rd annual "Live Fit Riverdale" should be nearing its 4th weekly activity. The purpose of "Live Fit" is to promote a healthy lifestyle. The weekly activities are also a fun way for individuals and families to get together with other members of the community. The activities are on Monday evenings, starting at 6:00 p.m. and last for about an hour with prize drawings at the end of each evening's activities. Remaining activities are 'Disc Golf' on May 9th at the Disc Golf Course south of the Civic Center, 'Run/Walk in the Park' on May 16th at the Riverdale Park on Parker Drive, and May 23rd will be the 'Awards Night' at the Community Center at 4360 S. Parker Drive. Activities, this year, include a "Triathlon Challenge." Three different levels of triathlons are available and to encourage a healthy life style, participants are allowed to take the full "Live Fit" program time of five weeks to complete their 'chosen' triathlon. Participants can also choose to complete individual 'legs' of the triathlons. They can also use stationary bikes, treadmills, etc. for the biking and run/walk legs and can row, use a real boat or a rowing machine to fill the swimming/rowing requirement if they don't have a pool available. The idea is to get people to set an achievable goal and then achieve it. This year, 187 residents signed up for "Live Fit." Of those registered, 103 signed up for the triathlons! Those serving on the committee, this year, are Katie Ellis, Mike Staten, Jenae Kinikin, Cassie Preece, Riley Schock and advisor Rich Taylor. We appreciate the committee's efforts in planning and staffing "Live Fit Riverdale" for 2016. We wouldn't have this worthwhile program without them!

MEMORIAL DAY CEREMONY



EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION REGISTRATION

The Emergency Reverse Notification System allows emergency officials in Riverdale to notify citizens and businesses in your neighborhood of emergency situations and emergency information. This may include information such as: Evacuation notifications, Public Works concerns, Missing children alerts, and Emergency conditions



This system primarily utilizes the 9-1-1 database for resident and business phone numbers. However, we recognize that many residents rely on their cell phones / email for emergency notifications and that many of our residents do not have land line phones in their homes. To address this, Weber County Emergency Management has teamed with CodeRED to create a registry system for cell phones and email.

To register your cell phone or email, please visit the city website at www.riverdalecity.com and follow the link on the homepage. When you are at the registry page please read all the information carefully before registering. If you have previously registered under the old system, your information was transferred to the CodeRED system.

The reverse notification system supplements, rather than replaces, other emergency communication methods including television, radio, websites, and other media. There is no substitute for personal preparation. In a disaster, government and other agencies may not be able to reach you and meet your needs. It is important for all residents to make individual plans and preparations for their care and safety during unexpected emergencies.

NEIGHBORHOOD BLOCK PARTIES
