NEW SIGN ON INTERSTATE 15

A new sign was recently placed on I-15 Southbound to provide motorists with directions to Riverdale Road. Previously there has not been a sign on I-15 southbound to advise motorists that they are approaching Riverdale City. The freeway exit to Riverdale Road is actually on I-84. This exit occurs after you leave I-15 heading for Wyoming and points east. Efforts have been made for many years to have a sign on southbound I-15 to make travelers and shoppers aware they are nearing our fine city. Due to Federal Highway Administration and Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) Rules and Regulations, a "Riverdale Sign" could not be put on southbound I-15 because the actual Riverdale Road exit is located on I-84. Many thanks to Kris Peterson and the Northern Region UDOT staff for making this happen. Thanks also to Riverdale City Administrator, Rodger Worthen, and Weber County Commissioner, Kerry Gibson, for their efforts in helping to make this much needed sign a reality. The new sign reads "Riverdale Road Use Exit 340" and is located just south of the 31st Street southbound on ramp!

ELECTION FILING PERIOD

The following offices are up for election this year: Mayor and two City Council Seats (each a four year term). Each person seeking to become a candidate for municipal office must file a Declaration of Candidacy, *in person* with the City Recorder and pay a non-refundable fee of \$25.00.

PROPER SUMP PUMP HOOK UP

If you have a sump pump to remove groundwater from your basement, we ask that you observe where the water is discharged to. Sump pumps must drain into your yard or the storm water system, not into the sanitary sewer system; which includes sinks, showers, toilets, etc..

Sanitary sewer systems are sized to handle sanitary sewer (water that requires treatment), not storm water (which includes water from sump pumps). When excess water enters the sanitary system it can cause sewage backups and put the treatment plant beyond capacity. Much of this excess water comes from sump pumps that are discharging into the sanitary sewer system. State and city laws prohibit the connection of storm water drains to the sanitary sewer, including sump pump discharges.

We ask that you help us by ensuring that your sump pump discharges into your yard or the storm water system, not into the sanitary sewer system. If you are unsure of where your sump pump discharges, please call our building official to ensure it is discharging properly. 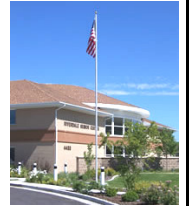
