



## MAYOR'S CORNER

### NEW OPTIONS AND SHORTER TRAVEL TIMES FOR RIVERDALE RESIDENTS

Those Riverdale residents who commute or travel to Salt Lake City and other points south can look for improved options and commute times with proposed improvements to US-89 and I-15. Vic Saunders from the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) recently announced improvements to US-89 from Farmington to the I-84 Interchange in South Weber. Vic noted the following:



- The environmental studies are complete, ready to move to construction in December or in the Spring
- The highway will be converted into an expressway or freeway, adding a lane in each direction
- Traffic lights will be gone with interchanges in place
- Cost is \$275 million to add a lane in each direction
- Frontage road will allow for bicyclists
- Will make for a big connection from Davis County to Weber State University
- UDOT is looking at the interchange at I-84, in South Weber, where there are ongoing issues, and are interested in changing the entire ramp system there, but the issue is funding
- Twenty right-of way purchases have been completed, most involve the frontage road

In addition, UDOT recently announced that construction on I-15 would begin in February of 2019 on new express lanes that would run from Layton City north to approximately 4400 South in Riverdale City. Once completed, the express lanes will run continuous from Riverdale south to Spanish Fork, a distance of about 80 miles.

### TRANSIENT CAMPS

Transient camps are found occasionally in Riverdale's wooded areas along the Weber River. These camps are sometimes difficult to spot when using the trail. If you should spot a transient camp, you are encouraged to call Riverdale Police at the non-emergency dispatch number 801-629-8221.

### SUMMER REMINDERS

As summer approaches, just a couple of reminders. I am already receiving phone calls from residents concerned with dogs being off leash along the river trail and other locations where residents bike, run or walk. Hopefully you will keep your dogs on a leash. Others may not view your dog as being as friendly as you do! Other residents are expressing concern of those watering their landscape during the hours from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. which is against our city ordinance and wastes about one-half of the water as it evaporates. Our winter snowpack was less than normal this past winter, so we should all be mindful of how we use it. We do live in a desert!

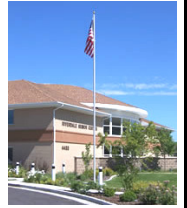

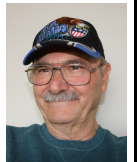
**SENIOR CENTER YARD SALE DONATIONS NEEDED**
