RIVERDALE CITY COURT RECEIVES "JUSTICE COURT OF THE YEAR" AWARD

The Riverdale City Court was honored at the City Council Meeting, held on April 16th, as it received the prestigious State of Utah, Administrative Office of the Courts "Justice Court of the Year" award. Judge Rueben Renstrom, who presides over the court, said the "court has worked diligently to improve the quality of life in the community. Each day, the clerks of this court work to strengthen the trust and confidence that the public has in the courts. In addition to handling cases, normally heard and processed by a Justice Court, the Riverdale City Court operates the only misdemeanor drug court in the state, and in doing so, allows defendants from Weber and Davis counties to participate in a cause to battle against the disease of addiction." Many, who have attended the 'drug court' have graduated and have overcome their addictions, finding a new lease on life!

ELECTION FILING PERIOD



The following offices are up for election this year: three (3) City Council Seats (each a four year term). Each eligible person seeking to become a candidate for municipal office must file a Declaration of Candidacy, in person with the City Recorder and pay a non-refundable fee of \$25.00. Please bring your government issued I.D., such as a driver's license, when you file.

Candidate requirements:

1. Registered voter.
2. Resident of Riverdale City, or recently annexed territory, for 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
3. In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored.

The filing period is June 3, 2019 to June 7, 2019; during regular office hours which are Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The 2019 Riverdale City Election Guide is available on the city website: www.riverdalecity.com; or at the Civic Center, 4600 South Weber River Drive, Riverdale, Utah, 84405. CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Construction has started on the projects listed below. Updated details are on the city website, www.riverdalecity.com. As always, please exercise caution when driving through construction areas.

- **Ritter Drive:** Construction is taking place on Ritter Drive. There will be closures of Ritter Drive during construction. The project is expected to take two months to complete.
- **I-84:** UDOT has started work on a preservation project on Interstate 84 from Riverdale Road to US 89.
- **I-15:** UDOT will extend the I-15 Express Lanes from Layton Parkway to Riverdale Road. Construction will continue through 2020. OPEN BURN SEASON



The State of Utah and Riverdale Fire Department allows for residential open burning of leaves, small branches, grass clippings, and other vegetation. The open burn seasons are March 30th to May 30th and September 15th to October 30th.

Homeowners wishing to burn must complete an open burn permit application with the Utah Division of Air Quality and follow these Burning instructions:

1. Obtain a burn permit from the Riverdale City Web page at www.riverdalecity.com.
2. Verify it is a "Green" burn day by checking the air quality forecast.
3. Check the weather and if wind is in the forecast, do not proceed.
4. Put in any needed fuel breaks and have a plan if your fire gets out of control.
5. Debris should be out in the open and not near structures or under trees that may catch fire.
6. Have a water supply available.
7. Tend the fire at all times (failure to do so is a Class B Misdemeanor).
8. Notify your local fire department dispatch (failure to do so is a Class B Misdemeanor).
9. You are liable for the costs if your fire escapes control.
10. Fires must be out cold before leaving the scene (failure to do so is a Class B Misdemeanor).
