- 1. Consideration of Ordinance 818 proposed amendment to RCC 10-14-11 Family Swimming Pool, Swim Spa and Hot Tub**

Motion: Councilor Arnold moved to adopt Ordinance 818 proposed amendment to RCC 10-14-11 Family Swimming Pool, Swim Spa and Hot Tub as written. Councilor Searle seconded the motion.

Roll Call Vote: Councilor Hunt, nay; Councilor Searle, aye; Councilor Arnold, aye; Councilor Mitchell, nay; and Councilor Staten, nay. The motion failed with two in favor and three opposed.

Motion: Councilor Mitchell moved to adopt Ordinance 818 proposed amendment to RCC 10-14-11 Family Swimming Pool, Swim Spa and Hot Tub with the removal of the language "not be less than twenty feet (20') from any livable area of a dwelling on an adjoining lot". Councilor Staten seconded the motion.

Roll Call Vote: Councilor Searle, nay; Councilor Arnold, aye; and Councilor Mitchell, aye; Councilor Staten, aye; and Councilor Hunt, aye. The motion passed with four in favor and one opposed.

Motion: Councilor Arnold moved to adopt Ordinance 819 proposed amendment to RCC 10-15-2 Parking Space for Dwellings as written. Councilor Staten seconded the motion.
